iPhone Overview





Icons

New Item
This notifies you that you have received a new item and the number of them. Items can include Email, Text Message, Calendar Invitation etc.
- 


Phone
Application to view Contacts, Favourites, Call History, Voicemail and Keypad (to make calls).
- 


Mail
Application to send and receive email.
- 


Calendar
This application is where you view, create appointments and respond to meeting requests.
- 


Safari
Internet browser.
- 


SMS/MMS Messaging
Application to send and receive text and picture messages.
- 


Clock
World Time, Alarms, Stopwatch and Countdown timer.
- 

Calculator
When iPhone is held vertically, a standard calculator.
When iPhone is held horizontally, a scientific calculator.
- 

Notes
A note pad. Anything typed up can be emailed to people
- 

Weather
Shows weather for the next 6 days in selected cities/regions.
- 

Google Maps
Directions on how to get from where you are to your destination.
Note: this feature does not include voice navigation
- 

Camera
Application to take still photos. (Video with iPhone 3GS)
- 

Settings
Where various configurable options for your phone are made.

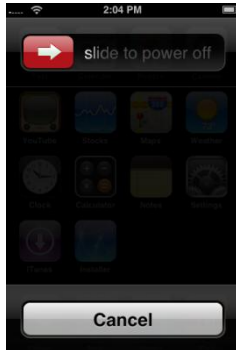
How do I?

Lock the phone

To lock the phone and prevent it from dialling accidentally: press the power button on the top. The screen will deactivate and you will hear a click. In this mode, the screen will not respond to input. The buttons however are still functional.

Power off the phone

Press and hold the power button for approx 5 seconds, then slide the red arrow to the right. To power on again, hold power button for a few seconds until the Apple logo appears.



Turn Bluetooth On/Off

From the Home screen open **Settings**.

Select **General**

Select **Bluetooth**

Switch **Off/On**

From here you can pair to or connect with a nearby Bluetooth device.

Turn Wireless On/Off

From the Home screen open **Settings**.

Select **Wi-Fi**

Switch **Off/On**

From here you can connect to a wireless network.

Lookup the phone number of someone on Exchange

From the home screen enter either **Contacts** or **Phone** and select **Contacts**.

In the top left corner, select **Groups**

Disable my iPhone for use in an aircraft

From the Home screen open **Settings**.

Next to **Airplane Mode**

Switch **Off/On**

Whilst Airplane Mode is on, Wireless, Bluetooth and the Phone component are all switched off.

How to change email password

Go into **Settings**

Select **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**

Under **Accounts**, select the account name eg. QUT Exchange

Select **Account Info**

Click into the **Password** field and press the home button to go exit

How to change wireless password

Go into **Settings**

Select **Wi-Fi**

Turn **Wi-Fi On**

If there is no tick next to QUT, please select it. After a moment it will ask you to re-enter your password.

How to turn on and use tethering

Go to **Settings**

Select **General**

Select **Network**

Select **Internet Tethering**

Turn **Internet Tethering On**

Now connect your iPhone via the sync cable or Bluetooth to use the internet

Frequently Asked Questions

1) I just unpacked my phone and it only shows a picture on the screen (below) and won't let me use it properly.



Before using your iPhone it must first be activated via iTunes. This will configure it for use on your mobile phone network.

2) I was using the phone now a strange logo appears and the phone won't do anything..



This is telling you that your battery is too low to continue using your device. Plug it into the charger and it will change to the screen below and you can continue to operate.



3) My phone has completely locked up and I can't turn it off.

Press the Power, Home and Volume Down buttons at the same time for approximately 10 seconds. This will send a power off command to the phone. You can turn it on again after a few seconds and continue to use the phone normally.
